The Heart of Jesus

“All of us, when we pause in silence, need to feel not only the beating of our own heart, but deeper still, the beating of a trustworthy presence, perceptible with faith's senses and yet much more real: the presence of Christ, the heart of the world.” (Par 66 Dilexit Nos) October 24th Pope Francis produced a new encyclical dealing with the heart of Jesus and our heart. It is a beautiful look into the human and divine heart. It is very readable. It can readily be found on the Vatican Website. The encyclical is entitled “Dilexit Nos” (He Loved Us). In celebration of this letter, we will be forming a discussion group to investigate how this deep and powerful teaching from our Pope can impact our lives. All are welcome 6:30 pm, Monday nights starting January 6th in the Chapel room of the old convent. “In this ‘liquid’ world of ours, we need to start speaking once more about the heart and thinking about this place where every person, of every class and condition, creates a synthesis, where they encounter the radical source of their strengths, convictions, passions and decisions.” (Par 9)
